He is co-author of *Insolvency Volumes: A Multi-Media Guide*, published by Jordans, and co-author of the ICAEW's *Guide to Turnaround Finance*. Mr. Jones is also a co-author of *Protected Cell Companies: A Guide To Implementation And Use*, published by Spiramus Press Ltd. and released in April 2008, the first book published worldwide on protected cell companies (PCCs). He is also co-author of the *Guide to Aviation Finance; Insolvency & Turnaround*, published by McGraw-Hill, and co-author of *The Pensions Act 2004: Finance & Insolvency*, published by Spiramus. Mr. Jones played a significant part in drafting a leasing accounting standard.

Mr. Jones sits on the education steering committee of R3 and is responsible for its e-learning pension program. He is a member of the arbitration panels of the London Court of International Arbitration, the ICAEW, and the Law Society of England and Wales, where he sits as an arbitrator mainly considering accounting-related disputes.

Before practicing law, Mr. Jones was the lead reconstruction partner in an accountancy practice.
